Rules and Regulations for Medina Fall Festival Exhibits

September 9, 2017 - Medina American Legion Hall

Entries will be judged with a blue, red and white ribbon awarded in each category with cash prizes. All other exhibits will be given participation ribbons.

Entries are open to everyone in the Medina trade area. Children are especially urged to exhibit.

All articles must be exhibited by the maker or grower. Articles must not have been exhibited previously at any fair. Worn, soiled or unfinished articles shall not be exhibited.

Entries to be judged will be accepted by the Exhibit Committee between 3 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. on Friday, September 8. No entries will be accepted on Saturday, September 9.

Exhibits shall not be removed without the consent of the committee. Exhibits cannot be removed until 3 p.m. and must be removed by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 9.

The committee will not be responsible for breakage or loss of any articles.

A

Grain Sheaves - 2 inch bundle

Grain - All grain must be clean and labeled, in pint jar

Corn - 1 stalk

B

Vegetables & Fruit - Label in lots of 5.

(Corn, potatoes, beets, carrots, tomatoes, apples, etc.)

Each type will be judged in its own category.

Place on Styrofoam/paper plate.

C

Baked Goods -

1- Cookies, Bars, Rolls, Muffins - Label in lots of 3.

2 - Cake, Pie, Bread - Label in lot of 1.

Each type will be judged in its own category.

Place on Styrofoam/paper plate, then enclose in Ziploc bag or cover with transparent wrap. If wrapped with transparent wrap, a second plate should be placed beneath to help hold covering secure.

D

Canned Goods - Label in lots of 3 in uniform jars.

(Pickles, jellies, jams, vegetables, fruits, etc.)

Each type will be judged in its own category.

Waxed sealed items will not be accepted.

E

Knitted Items - (afghans, scarves, etc.)

1 - By hand

2 - By machine

F

Crocheted Items (afghans, doilies, etc.)

Needlework should be mounted on colored tissue or cardboard.

G

Embroidery and Needlepoint (pictures, dresser scarves, etc.)

H

Quilts

1 - Hand quilted

2 - Machine quilted

3 - Tied

I

Quilted Items (placemats, table runners, wall hangings, etc.)

J

Ceramics - Lot of 1

K

Woodworking - Lot of 1

L

Sewn Articles (clothing, home décor, etc.)

M

Photography - Lot of 1

N

Mammoth Booth - (fruits, vegetables, etc.)

Items will be judged by size and weight.
